

WITH COFFEE AND
MILK CHOCOLATE TRUFFLE

Specially selected by us—the joy—from Warehouse No. Two. Unbottled and for tasting only here and now.

Translucent like a nitrous gas. Chilli peppers left on a steel blade. Wrangle this metallic lava with 1970s strong black milk coffee. Silky and velvet, yet gritty and robust.

WITH A PASSION FRUIT
MANGO TRUFFLE:

A quarter of a century in a refill hogshead—one of only 5,916. Glance at the subdued amber...the floral scent catches you unaware. A waxed jacket in a spring shower. Dig deep for orange peelings and Scots pine. Remember that laced apricot trifle in the summer. The passion and the spirit combine and linger long.

WITH AN ORANGE CRUNCH:

One of only 6,000 bottles. A whiff of hot calvados, crème brûlée with maple syrup, chomping apples in an oak barrel, clean heat from a steel pan simmering forest berries. The chill takes you free-riding down a brandy apple sorbet piste melting into a toasty après-ski bothy. The rugged comfort of the orange chocolate spirals hazily into the amber spirit. Relax with your friends in a jaffa sunset on the rocks.

WITH MILK VELVET
TRUFFLE

At 1,164 feet above sea level the distillery is the highest in Scotland, and in the coldest location. Smooth and subtle malt. Discover creamy vanilla, heather honey and just a hint of Highland smoke, marrying beautifully with the smoothness of the Velvet, allowing the honeybees of this heathery Highland malt to dance.

WITH STRAWBERRY AND
STAR ANISE TRUFFLE

Double-matured in Oloroso cask wood. Muscavado toffee and lemon on the nose. Peat, heather and spice lightly dance on a sunny day. Clear honey ebbs and flows over the tongue. The warmth of the malt resonates overall. A dry vanilla finish. The sweetest strawberries in June served with toffee & star anise cake. An old-fashioned cottage garden conquered by the cask wood.

WITH HAZELNUT CRÈME PRALINE

From spirit distilled between October and March. A warm low January sunset, with hints of spicy honey in the air. Soda pop of winter leaves—a fizz on the tongue. Earthy with a slight bitter hint. Hibernate with the smooth crème nuttiness and feel the inner glow.
